

BY-LAWS OF THE LIBERTARIAN PARTY OF

Osceola County, FL.

ARTICLE I:

The Libertarian Party of Osceola County, hereinafter referred to as LPoOC shall adopt the Constitution and By-Laws of the Libertarian Party of Florida as its basic guidance.

Article II Executive Committee Meetings

The LPoOC Executive Committee shall meet each month at a time and place to be determined. A quorum necessary to conduct any and all business at this monthly business meeting will consist of a simple majority of the Executive Committee, however two officers must be present and voting.

SECTION III

Only members of the Executive Committee, as defined by the LPoOC Constitution shall be eligible to vote at monthly meetings.

SECTION IV

Robert's Rules of Order, latest edition, shall be the parliamentary authority for all matters of procedure not specifically covered by these by-laws or the Constitution of the LPoOC County.

ARTICLE II: SUSPENSION AND SUCCESSION.

SECTION I

The LPoOC may secede from the Libertarian Party of Florida with a two-third majority voter.

SECTION II

The LPoOC shall present to the Libertarian Party of Florida a written progress report once every three calendar months delivered to the Regional Representative for the Affiliate.
