THE CITY OF KISSIMMEE SPEAKS ABOUT ENDING TERM LIMITS FOR MAYOR

Libertarians Stand Against This Action

Osceola, FL, May 15, 2018– Today our chair will be addressing the City of Kissimmee Commission, regarding item 8.A. of the May 15, 2018, agenda.

It states:

8.A. KISSIMMEE CITY COMMISSION TERM LIMITS

The request is for the City Commission to consider a citizen request to amend the City Charter regarding term limits for the seat of Mayor/Commissioner.

As mentioned at previous meetings the Libertarian Party of Osceola County stands strongly against any ending of term limits within the city. “We have discussed this so many times already and it seems that the same people keep bringing up the topic even though the general public has spoken against it,” said Libertarian Chair, Marcos Marrero, about the item being brought up by Democrat Chair, Leah Carius.

Carius had spoken in December 2017 when Commissioner Eady proposed a similar measure, that was left as a discussion item after residents voiced their disfavor for the idea. Chair Person, Marcos Marrero will be reiterating the same comments made at the December meeting to the commission today.
